IMPORTANT CAMP INSURANCE INFORMATION

Please note that Woodland has a new policy on insurance coverage for campers and staff for the 2012 camp season. This is explained below:

Woodland Bible Camp provides medical insurance coverage (accident and/or illness) for all registered youth and adult participants while participating in overnight Camp activities sponsored and supervised by the Camp; while traveling during such activities as a member of a group in transportation furnished or arranged by the Camp; or traveling directly to or from the Insured's home premises and the site of such activities. Coverage is limited to: \$25,000 per accident or \$5,000 per illness. Therefore, you should also include a copy of the front and back of the attendee's personal insurance card for any camper or staff.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Due to new insurance regulations, if campers will be involved in off-site activities for any Camp related activity such as visiting churches during Music Week or visiting the Linton Swimming Pool or Park, these activities will be reported to the insurance company at least two weeks in advance of the Camp related activity. As the schedules for the specific camp weeks become finalized in the future, any such activities will be posted on the Camp's website.
